The Homeowners Association of Sterling Hills met for its Annual Meeting on November 8, 2011. The meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. at the Gotcha Covered Building in Lincoln, Nebraska. The agenda was distributed by Marlene Swanson an employee of SNB Construction. The attached list is everyone present at the meeting.

Items for discussion were snow removal; residents complained that snow had been pushed in front of the mail boxes limiting access thereto. A question was poised to SNB, the management company, whether or not the snow could be moved to some other point.

There was a discussion regarding garbage pickup and recycling. The residents wondered if they could have a recycling can, and would it be picked up at a different date or at the same time, and would there be additional charges. Also, what would be available for recycling?

Next item on the agenda was parking. There was a request by some residence to have parking on only one side of the street, but it was felt that the streets were too narrow for that. There is also a problem with vehicles parking in front of driveways. It was suggested that a sign be posted saying that cars parked illegally, or blocking driveways will be towed at the owner's expense. It was also suggested that the neighbors contact those who have vehicles parked in their driveway to ask them to please remove them and be aware that they should inform their guests to avoid parking in front of driveways.

There was also a complaint about noise at a particular residence that was rented out to four young men, and that this was causing a nuisance.

Paul Schelstraete, President of City Bank & Trust Co raised the question that the directors have not been elected to the best of his knowledge after talking with other residents. That a director was to serve for a term of three years and that a new director would be elected each year and that there have been no elections according to the home owners who have lived there for over five years. Paul Schelstraete said that if $2/3^{rd}$ of those who are able to vote that were present could vote to remove the current board of directors. A motion was made to have a vote as to the removal of the board of directors; a vote was made and over 2/3rds of those present voted for the removal of the board of directors; motion carried. The members then were advised that they could elect a new board. Nominations were made for directors. There being no further nominations, it was put to a vote, all property owners present at the meeting voted; the top three nominees to receive votes to serve as directors were Paula Dicero, Gerald Hauder, and Brian Kamler.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
